

DID YOU KNOW THAT THE CITY OF SCOTTSDALE WILL PICK UP HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE AT YOUR HOME?

Simply sign up for collection on the city website and tell us what type of waste you need to have picked up.

Residential utility customers may use the Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Home Collection Program three times per calendar year at no charge. The costs are already included in your garbage rates.

HOW DOES HHW HOME COLLECTION WORK?

STEP 1:

Visit the city website at ScottsdaleAZ.gov and search HHW. Fill out the home collection form and explain the type of waste you wish to have picked up from your home.

STEP 2:

You will receive a confirmation email from the city with the anticipated pickup dates. The day before your collection appointment an email reminder will be sent.

STEP 3:

To make sure we collect your hazardous waste, please place it by your front door or garage by 7 a.m. on your collection day. For your safety and the safety of our crew, please keep all containers to a maximum of 5 gallons and a total of 20 gallons or less.

WHY SHOULD I HAVE HAZARDOUS WASTE PICKED UP?

Hazardous waste can be dangerous at home, it's not good for the landfill and does not belong in your curbside container. Dispose of hazardous waste properly and future generations will thank you.



WHAT CAN BE PICKED UP?

FROM YOUR HOUSE:

- Aerosol cans
- Ammonia
- Cleaners and spot removers
- NiCad batteries
- Photo chemicals and chemistry sets
- Oven cleaners
- Bleaches
- Drain cleaners
- Fire extinguishers

FROM YOUR GARAGE:

- Car batteries
- Engine degreasers
- All engine fluids
- Gasoline
- Kerosene

FROM YOUR YARD:

- Insecticides, weed killers and poisons
- Pesticides
- Fertilizer
- Herbicides
- Rodent killers
- Swimming pool chemicals

FROM YOUR WORKBENCH:

- Oil and latex paint (20-gallon limit)
- Adhesives
- Hobby supplies

- Sealers
- Solvents
- Rust preventatives
- Spray paint
- Stain thinners and strippers

WHAT IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR PICKUP?

- Biological waste
- Ammunition
- Leaking containers
- Large appliances (Call us to have our crews pick them up at your home for recycling.)
- Electronics (we recycle E-Waste four times a year. Visit our web page for details.)
- Radioactive materials
- Commercial chemicals (for business use)
