- Evening Board Meetings: Don Couture reported that there were 10 responses to the email survey: 5 for evening, 3 against, 2 neutral. Thus 2% of residents want evening meetings. The issue will not be considered.
- Street Lighting: Craig Sjodin has bulbs and sensors.



- The board voted *not* to remove the Sissoo tree in front of the Ramada. The roots are invasive, according to San Barnes (Landscape Committee), who was concerned about the closeness to the Ramada and messy leaf droppings on neighbors' yard. Bill Mucci noted that the sewage lines are checked twice per year to assure sewage lines are clear.
